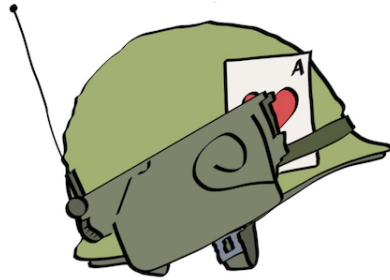


LEAD

Overall responsibility for the mission and the team.

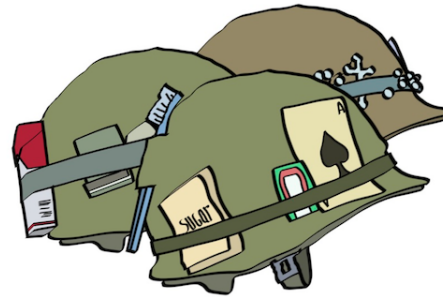
More a tactical role, ensuring the team achieves the next check-point. Keep the overall direction, briefing the team on the next mission and knowing what mission comes after.

Accountable for navigating the team to the next check-point.

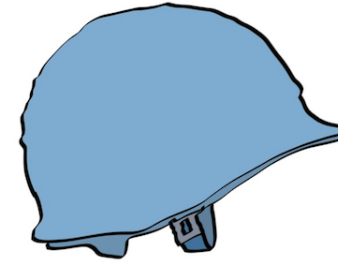
More a strategic role, The master of communication, the owner of the map, plotting the route to the next check-point. Driver, keeping the team moving.



BRUTE FORCE

A team of bad-asses, ready to dive into hostile territory, and either return victorious or not return at all.

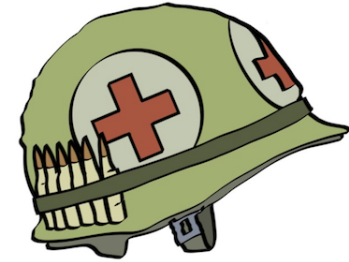
A group of recruits that are ready to remove any obstacles or resolve any issues along the way.
